Built by Aubi, the building was financed through a loan by Libro. This is the single biggest financial investment made by the volunteer Board of Directors. "We are honoured to bring this new facility to London. It provides new energy to a much-loved organization," says Gary Curtis, President, Board of Directors.

Boler Mountain is Southwestern Ontario's most dynamic destination for outdoor adventure. It attracts over 120,000 enthusiastic outdoor participants annually to the facility from all over southwestern Ontario. Boler Mountain has become a part of many area families lives and an important part of their healthful, active outdoor winter lifestyle. The organization strives to provide year round experiences for guests of all ages and abilities to enjoy extraordinary fun and excitement.
