



Drone Policy

Boler Mountain

At Boler Mountain, the landing and take-off of an unmanned air vehicle (UAV) – also known as a drone – is prohibited.

In Canada, a UAV is considered aircraft. Their use is governed by Transport Canada.

Anyone wishing to use a UAV on or within the air space over Boler Mountain must submit a written proposal to marty@bolermountain.com clearly indicating how the intended use of the UAV supports the the goals of Boler Mountain. If approved, a Restricted Activity Permit will be issued and Boler will require a certificate of insurance naming Boler in the policy.

A Special Flight Operations Certificate (SFOC) may also be required from Transport Canada for the UAV depending on its weight.
