



Notification of Treatment for Gypsy Moths

Dear Neighbors,

At a significant cost to Boler Mountain we intend to aerial spray a bio-pesticide to help control the Gypsy Moth outbreak that is currently affecting Boler Mountain. This is similar to what the City of London is doing in various area parks as well as there is a widespread outbreak throughout London.

We will be using a contracted aerial spray service and they will be applying a product called Foray 48B also known as Btk. It is a bacteria, not a chemical and has been used for decades in residential areas. This application will not wipeout the gypsy moths but will help reduce the problem and decrease the amount of ongoing tree damage.

The projected date of the first spray is May 8-16 with the date being impacted by weather and the timing of the caterpillar hatch. A second spray will follow 5-7 days later.
