- 3. Boler Mountain reserves the right to remove a season pass or lift ticket at their discretion.
- A \$20.00 charge will be made for replacement of lost passes. Minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian when replacing a lost pass.
- Passes are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Season passes must be worn and visible at all times while at the ski area. Lift ticket will not be issued for a forgotten pass.
- 7. The management reserves the right to close the area at any time it deems it unsafe to the public.

- 9. Season passes will not be released until the online season pass waiver has been completed.

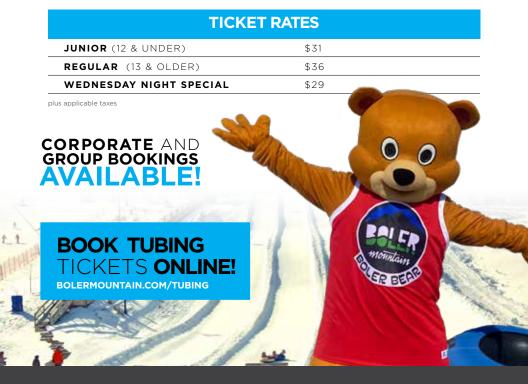

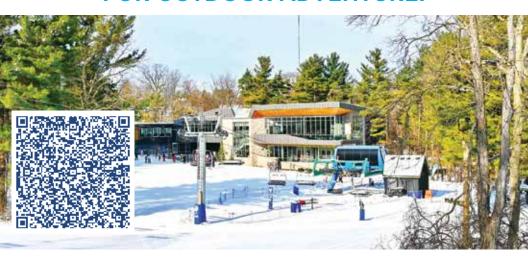
