What to Expect When You Arrive at Boler Mountain

CHECK-IN

When you arrive at Boler Mountain, drive all the way up the driveway to the main chalet. Please have all students **remain on the bus** while one teacher or volunteer reports your arrival to our Welcome Centre. The remainder of the day will be organized and facilitated by our staff. If the bus has to drop off students and leave, have students line up at the side of The Welcome Centre while a teacher or volunteer checks in.

SAFETY TALK

A Boler Mountain staff member will greet your group outside of the Welcome Centre and accompany you to your meeting area inside. Safety, rules, course usage, weather conditions, helmets, harnesses, equipment and personal belongings will be reviewed during our Safety Talk.

EQUIPMENT

Safety is our main priority at Boler Mountain that is why we utilize the best and most current equipment on the market. Our Treetop Adventure Park uses Petzl full body harnesses and Petzl helmets. Boler Mountain has chosen to use the revolutionary Edelrid Smart Belay System, **which ensures that the participant cannot become completely unclipped from the lifeline**. All of our equipment is certified and routinely inspected. All equipment required to participate will be provided by Boler Mountain.



TEACHERS & VOLUNTEERS

We offer 1 complimentary teacher/parent volunteer ticket for every 10 students. Above and beyond the complimentary tickets, teachers/parent volunteers will pay the school rate.

Please Note: The prices above are for School Group Programs only. **For every 10 students, 1 adult Teacher/Volunteer** receives a complimentary admission into our Treetop Adventure Park. **Minimum of 30 students required upon booking.** The Treetop Adventure Park is recommended for students in Grade 4 and up. School Group rates are only available on weekdays during the months of May, June, September and October. Minimum number of students is 30.

Payment can be made prior to your departure, with the option of paying by cash, credit card, debit or cheque (made payable to Boler Mountain). Invoicing is possible and the school can follow up with payment after the trip. The main contact will be provided an invoice before the end of the day.

Boler Mountain has financial assistance available for students otherwise not able to participate in the program. Please contact Jessika Gunton, Programs Director for further information.

How Does the School Program Work?

Groups have up to 4 hours to complete the course. Groups of students will be taken through our Demonstration Course with a certified Guide. The guide will teach the students about their equipment and how to use the Treetop Adventure Park. All students will have to demonstrate their ability to follow Boler Mountain's safety practices before entering the course. This takes approximately 20-30 minutes. Following the Demo Course, students will be escorted to the Treetop Adventure Park where they can adventure and explore for the remainder of their time. There is no set time for lunch. Students can go up into the course and when they are finished for the day, they can make their way back to the main chalet. They can eat the lunch they brought with them, or the lunch they pre-ordered or purchased from Boler. The Boler Treetop Staff will let students know how much time is left before they need to start making their way to the chalet to get on the bus.

What Should Students & Parents Know About Boler Mountain's Treetop Adventure Park?

CERTIFICATIONS

Our Treetop Adventure Park guides are trained according to the most recent industry standards. All of ziplines are certified by the Technical Safety Standards Act (TSSA). Courses are inspected daily by our certified Treetop guides.

CLOTHING & RECOMMENDED GEAR

Please ensure that students are dressed appropriately for the weather. A positive experience starts with being comfortable. Choose clothing and footwear that is appropriate for outdoor activities. Please take into account daily weather and dress appropriately. Remember that layering clothing is a great way to stay warm. If you get too hot, you can always take off a layer. We suggest that students bring an extra change of clothing because we can't predict the weather. Having something dry and comfortable to wear on the ride home is always good after being outside all day.

Below are clothing guidelines you should consider:

- Avoid wearing jeans as they restrict movement
- Shorts must reach the knee or lower thigh
- Please avoid loose clothing and tops with drawstrings
- Running shoes are required; **no open toed shoes are allowed.**
- Gloves are recommended, but optional; we sell gloves in the main office
- Do not wear jewelry, such as long earrings, bracelets or necklaces
- Ensure long hair is tied back
- Phones can be taken into the course. Just make sure they are secured in a pocket with a zipper.



WEATHER

Boler Mountain's Treetop Adventure Park operates **rain or shine!** Please ensure that students are dressed appropriately for the weather with a waterproof jacket, pants & shoes. In the event of thunder & lightning, high winds or heavy downpour we will temporarily close the course.

LUNCH & CAFETERIA

There is no set time for lunch. When students have completed as much of the Treetop Adventure Park as they wish to do, they can make their way back to the main chalet. They can eat the lunch they brought with them, or they can purchase their lunch from Boler. We will have a variety of food items such as snacks, hot food, cold food and beverages available at a reasonable cost. Boler Mountain will have lunch options available for students to purchase or teachers can pre-order lunch combos for the group in advance (minimum order # required). Pre-ordered lunch options can be ready for your group when you complete the course and can be added to your invoice. You are also welcome to bring your own lunch from home.

PARTICIPATION

The Boler Mountain Treetop Adventure Park operates on a “challenge by choice” policy. We encourage all students to try the course, conquer their fears and participate in this unique activity, but if they choose not participate; there is a trail on the ground below the course where they can walk underneath. Those who finish the course early can also follow along below the course. It is a great place to watch, cheer on friends and take photos.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Students will be able to leave their belongings in cubbies in the Welcome Centre. We suggest that you leave valuable items at home the day of your trip.

Boler Mountain is not responsible for the loss of any personal items.

MEDICAL CONDITIONS

Please ensure that the group leader is aware of the students’ medical conditions and passes the information to the lead guide on the day of your visit.
